Glossary:

<u>Proficiency Level:</u> Score on test at which students meet or exceed expectations for proficiency on each assessment.

<u>State Standard:</u> The State Board of Education minimum requirement is that 75% of students in 4th, 6th and 9th grades are at or above the proficient level on statewide assessments. The standard increases to 85% of students at the proficient level for the results on the 9th grade proficiency test at the end of 10th grade. The non-test standards are a 90% graduation rate and a 93% attendance rate.

<u>Similar Districts:</u> School districts similar to yours based on comparing district size, poverty levels, socioeconomic status (family income, education levels, professions) and factors related to urban or rural location and overall property wealth.


