**Community**

Fort Loramie, Ohio a community of 1,497 (Census 2012) is located in Southwest Ohio (Shelby County). Surrounding cities include Sidney Ohio, located approximately 15 miles Southeast, and other major cities such as Cincinnati, Columbus, Dayton, Lima, Toledo, and Fort Wayne, Indiana are all located within 50-100 miles of Fort Loramie.

Approximately 23.5% of Fort Loramie residents hold a Bachelors degree. In addition, 8.5% hold a Graduate or professional degree. The median household income is \$64,304 (US Census Bureau, 2012). The unemployment rate is 6.5% and the median house or condo value is \$151,364 (US Census Bureau, 2012).

Fort Loramie is within commuting distance of several institutions of higher learning including the following: Ohio State University-Lima, Rhodes State College, University of Northwestern Ohio, Wright State University-Lake Campus, Edison State Community College, Wright State University (Main Campus) and The University of Dayton.

**District**

Spanning 42 square miles, Fort Loramie School District serves the educational needs of Fort Loramie, Ohio. Currently, the district consists of one elementary school and one junior/senior high school utilizing a K-6 and 7-12 configuration.

For the 2014-2015 school year, the district was given a rating of Excellent in the report card. This marks the tenth consecutive year that the district has earned this score. In addition, the Fort Loramie Local Schools has a Performance Index that rates the Fort Loramie Local Schools #15 in the State of Ohio.

Fort Loramie High School is a comprehensive four year high school that offers a wide range of courses which are compatible to each student's interests, abilities, needs, and post high school plans. The fall enrollment for the 2016-2017 school year is 381. Fort Loramie High School will continue to operate on a modified block scheduling format for the 2016-2017 school year. Students schedule their normal course load, a lunch and Tribe Time, which is used for extra help, homework, intervention, etc. The modified block schedule provides more instructional time for staff and students and incorporates an Intervention/Enrichment period into the schedule to support and stretch the abilities of our students.

Fort Loramie Elementary School was recognized as a 2014 National Blue Ribbon School by the US Department of Education. We offer many different programs to help each child succeed. Fort Loramie Elementary utilizes both
