BOARD BRIEFS

The following is a summary of the Regular Board of Education meeting held on October 15, 2018.

- The Board approved minutes of the Regular Business Meeting held on September 17, 2018. The monthly financial report indicated September General Fund receipts of \$441,709 and expenditures of \$691,977. The anticipated carry-over balance for the end of the 2017-2018 fiscal year is \$7,813,706.
- The September lunchroom report showed a loss of \$266.44. The average number of lunches served per day was 489.
- In the Elementary Principal's report, Scott Rodeheffer reported as follows:
 1. We will be conducting our ALICE drill on October 19th. Teachers do know that there will be a drill this day, but they do not know what time.
 2. The third graders will be taking the Fall ELA AIR assessment on October 30th and 31st.
- In the Junior/Senior High School report, Mr. Hollenbacher reported as follows:

STUDENT PARTICIPATION

The Board was provided a list of how many students are participating in a fall sport or the band per grade level. Last meeting it was reported that roughly 70 percent of FLHS students are involved in a fall sport or the band. To continue those numbers, roughly half of our high school students are also involved in a second club activity during the fall (and of those students, for more than half of them, they are not just involved in two activities – but they are involved in 3 to 4 activities this fall). Again, it is numbers like these that are not reported by ODE, but are significant reasons that make our school an excellent one.
