## **BOARD BRIEFS**

The following is a summary of the Regular Board of Education meeting held on November 19, 2018.

- The Board approved minutes of the Regular Business Meeting held on October 15, 2018. The monthly financial report indicated October General Fund receipts of \$993,321 and expenditures of \$691,877. The anticipated carry-over balance for the end of the 2017-2018 fiscal year is \$7,444,228.
- The October lunchroom report showed a loss of \$449.22. The average number of lunches served per day was 509.
- In the Elementary Principal's report, Scott Rodeheffer reported as follows:
  1. We will have our K-6 Christmas concert on December 3rd in the High School Gym. It will begin at 7:00pm. The students will be singing "Christmas Classics."
  2. The Spelling Bee will be conducted on December 7th at 9:30am in the Elementary Cafeteria. We have 24 students in grades 4-8 competing this year.
  3. Kids Korus and 5th & 6th grade band will be performing their Christmas concert on December 17th at 7:00pm in the Jr. High gym.
- In the Junior/Senior High School report, Mr. Hollenbacher reported as follows:
