BOARD BRIEFS

The following is a summary of the Regular Board of Education meeting held on December 17, 2018.

- Approved fall sports State proclamations.
- The Board approved minutes of the Regular Business Meeting held on November 19, 2018. The monthly financial report indicated November General Fund receipts of \$414,918 and expenditures of \$662,446. The anticipated carry-over balance for the end of the 2017-2018 fiscal year is \$7,444,228.
- The November lunchroom report showed a loss of \$2,428.47. The average number of lunches served per day was 507.
- In the Elementary Principal's report, Scott Rodeheffer reported as follows:
 1. We will have 56 fifth grade students graduating from DARE on Wednesday, January 19th at Jackson Center.
 2. Gifted testing will be the week of January 7th. Second and fourth grade will be taking the assessments.
