BOARD BRIEFS

The following is a summary of the Regular Board of Education meeting held on February 18, 2019.

- The Board approved minutes of the Organizational Meeting on January 9, 2019 and the Regular Business Meeting held on January 9, 2019. The monthly financial report indicated January General Fund receipts of \$958,389 and expenditures of \$743,742. The anticipated carry-over balance for the end of the 2018-2019 fiscal year is \$8,113,981.
- The January lunchroom report showed a loss of \$3,384.85. The average number of lunches served per day was 515.
- In the Elementary Principal's report, Scott Rodeheffer reported as follows:
 1. Grandparent's day will be March 1st at 1:30. Kindergarten-second grade will be presenting songs and skits to the grandparents. We will have punch and cookies afterwards.
 2. Right to Read week will be March 4th-8th. The theme this year is Dino-Mite Book Fare, Stomp, Chomp, and Read. We have Imax coming in on Monday, March 4th to start the week off with a Movie about dinosaurs and popcorn.
- In the Junior/Senior High School report, Mr. Hollenbacher reported as follows:

AP/CCP MEETING

This past Wednesday night, we had our final AP/College Credit Plus (CCP) meeting. This meeting is mandatory for any student wanting to take an AP Class or CCP courses next year. We had representatives from Wright State, Edison, Rhodes, and Urbana in attendance; and the meetings were well attended. The first meeting was for returning students, the second meeting for first time students. All together, we had 89 students attend to show interest in AP or CCP classes for next year; which is good and about on average with prior years.
