BOARD BRIEFS

The following is a summary of the Regular Board of Education meeting held on September 17, 2018.

- The Board approved minutes of the Regular Business Meeting held on August 20, 2018. The monthly financial report indicated August General Fund receipts of \$776,009 and expenditures of \$1,121,764. The anticipated carry-over balance for the end of the 2017-2018 fiscal year is \$7,813,706.
- In the Elementary Principal's report, Scott Rodeheffer reported as follows:
 1. We will be having some professional development for our 5th and 6th grade teachers this Wednesday over our new reading series, ReadyGen. In October all of the teachers will have a half day training on MAP data. These will be small groups in order to help the teachers dive into the data to better understand and identify individual student strengths and weaknesses.
 2. Red Ribbon Week will be Oct. 8-12.
- In the Junior/Senior High School report, Mr. Hollenbacher reported as follows:

STUDENT PARTICIPATION

The Board was provided a list of how many students are participating in a fall sport or the band per grade level. We have roughly 70 percent of our students involved in a school activity, which is great. It is numbers like these that are not reported by ODE, but make our school an excellent one.

OPEN LUNCH

This past Friday was our first open lunch for Juniors and Seniors. We are planning on providing this once a month for our students, as a reward for the students who are here for classes at FLHS during this time.

 - The new Chromebooks have arrived and been implemented at the elementary.
 - The dates for the Fall, Winter and Spring sports awards were shared with the Board.
 - Updated the Board on the two Women's Self-Defense classes that were held at the elementary in conjunction with the Shelby County Sheriff Department and Fort Loramie Village Police department.
 - Reviewed upcoming dates of importance.
