# SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS:

## **SOS – Save Our Supply – High School Scholarship Assistance Program**

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Applicant must be a high school senior.
- Applicant does not have to be a blood donor, but blood donor applicants, or applicants that recruit volunteer blood donors will be given special consideration.
- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident
- Applicant's high school must sponsor one blood drive with CBC during the school year (June, 2010 through May, 2011).
- Applicant must have a cumulative 2.5 GPA or higher
- Applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from a blood drive faculty member, teacher, or principal.
- Applicant must include an official copy of the high school transcript including first semester senior grades.
- Applicants must submit their Donor Recruitment Campaign: **“As a blood-drive chairperson, your goal is to encourage your student body to donate blood for your annual high school blood drive. You are to create a campaign described in 300 to 500 words, and include at least 3 support materials, one of which could be an educational video that communicates why blood donation is important and what donors should do prior to the blood drive to help ensure a successful donation.”**
