Community Foundation of Shelby County Scholarships

_____ Dr. Edward and Anne Link Fund Scholarship ***Past Graduates ONLY***

Application deadline: **June 1, 2011**

- Shelby County residents maintaining a college gpa of not less than 3.0 on a 4.0 grading scale and are pursuing a major in Fine Arts toward an Associate's, a Bachelor's, or a Master's degree at an accredited college or university.
- Applicants must have completed at least one year of post-secondary education. No recipient may be awarded this scholarship more than once.
- Selection based upon: academic ability, demonstrated community and school service, and recommendations.

Award: One \$1,500 scholarship.

_____ Medical & Health Professions Scholarship ***Past Graduates May Also Apply***

Application deadline: **June 1, 2011**

- Graduates of high schools within Shelby County or residents of any public school district within Shelby County pursuing a certificate or an Associates, Bachelors, or Masters degree in medical and health professions. Eligible persons may apply during any year of their education.
- Selection based upon: financial need, academic ability, demonstrated community and school service, and recommendations.
- Must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Individuals who have not been enrolled in high school or a post-secondary program within the last two years need not comply with this requirement.

Award: Two \$1,000 scholarships.

_____ Catherine Moloney Nursing Scholarship ***Past Graduates May Also Apply***

Application deadline: **June 1, 2011**

- A Shelby County resident pursuing a Registered Nursing degree.
- Eligible persons may apply during any year of their education; however licensed RN's are not eligible for continuing education.
- Selection based upon: financial need, academic ability, demonstrated "empathy which is necessary, the compassion which is required, and the requisite patience in order to enjoy and devote oneself to a long and fruitful nursing career."

Award: One \$1,000 scholarship.

_____ Heidi Norris Fund Scholarship ***Past Graduates ONLY***

Application deadline: **June 1, 2011**

- A Shelby or Mercer County resident who has surpassed college freshman status and has maintained a gpa of not less than 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Must be pursuing a major in Respiratory Therapy or a closely related field with the intent of earning an Associates, Bachelors, or Masters degree at an accredited college or university.
- Selection based upon: financial need, academic ability, demonstrated community and school service, and recommendations.

Award: One \$750 scholarship.

_____ William B. and Bonnie Z. Swonger Nursing Scholarship ***Past Graduates May Also Apply***

Application deadline: **June 1, 2011**

- Any Shelby County resident who is a graduate of (or is about to graduate from) any high school within Shelby County and is pursuing a Registered Nursing degree.
- Eligible persons may apply during any year of their education; however licensed RN's are not eligible for continuing education.
- Selection based upon: financial need and academic ability.

Award: Three \$1,000 scholarships available.

_____ June Whited Christian Science Scholarship ***Past Graduates May Also Apply***

Application deadline: **June 1, 2011**

- High school students or graduates who reside, or have resided, in Ohio who are pursuing a four-year degree at Principia College, Elsau, Illinois in the coming academic year. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- Selection based upon: academic ability, financial need, demonstrated community and school service, and demonstrated moral standards within the doctrine of The First Church of Christ, Scientist.
- Eligible applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- **Please attach a brief personal statement** (not more than 400 words) demonstrating how you live your life by the doctrine of The First Church of Christ, Scientist, Boston, MA.

Award: One \$1,800 scholarship.
