Community

Fort Loramie, Ohio is a community of 1,592 (Census 2020) located in Southwest Ohio (Shelby County). Surrounding cities include Sidney, 15 miles Southeast and Wapakoneta, 25 miles Northwest. Other major cities such as Dayton, Lima, Cincinnati, Columbus, Toledo, and Fort Wayne are all located with-in 50-100 miles of Fort Loramie.

Approximately 28.85% of Fort Loramie residents hold a Bachelors degree. In addition, 8.5% hold a Graduate or professional degree. The median household income is \$70,375 (US Census Bureau, 2020). The unemployment rate is 4.5% and the

median house or condo value is \$215,786 (US Census Bureau, 2020).

Fort Loramie is within

commuting distance of several institutions of higher learning including the following: Ohio State University-Lima, Rhodes State College, University of Northwestern Ohio, Wright State University—Lake Campus, Edison State Community College, Wright State University (Main Campus), and The University of Dayton.

District

Spanning 42 square miles, Fort Loramie School District serves the educational needs of Fort Loramie, Ohio. Currently, the district consists of one elementary school and one junior/senior high school utilizing a K-6 and 7-12 configuration.

Fort Loramie Local School District earned a Performance Index of 106.8 for the 2021-2022 AIR Assessments, which ranks them among the top school districts in Ohio. They earned an overall 5 Star Rating.

Fort Loramie Elementary School is a 2019 OAE-SA Hall of Fame School and was recognized as a 2014 National Blue Ribbon School by the US Department of Education. We offer many different programs to help each child succeed.

Fort Loramie Elementary utilizes both resource room and co-teaching in our special education



program, two reading intervention specialists, and a gifted specialist. Two special programs we offer are pro-social classes for every grade and Primary Education Thinking Skills (P.E.T.S) programming in first through third grade, which places emphasis on convergent and divergent thinking skills. We currently have a 1 to 1 Chromebook program in second through sixth grades. Some of the extra-curricular programs offered are Kids Korus, running club, and LEGO League.
