Introduction:

The Fort Loramie Education Foundation (FLEF) is a non-profit community foundation whose purpose is exclusively educational and charitable. The Foundation's mission is to operate for the benefit of Fort Loramie Local School's students and recent graduates pursuing educational advancement. One function of the FLEF is to facilitate annual scholarship awards.

Selection Process:

A scholarship selection committee, separate from the FLEF committee, will select recipients based on the submitted application, essay, established eligibility qualifications and selection criteria for each scholarship as listed in the following pages.

General Guidelines:

- All FLEF scholarships will be awarded to Fort Loramie High School graduates only.
- Scholarship checks will only be made out to the education institution upon evidence of enrollment after the first grading period and within one year of being awarded.
- Scholarship award selections shall be made without regard or consideration of gender, race, ethnic background, physical disability or religious affiliation or non-affiliation.
