Use your thinking skills.

<u>Criteria</u> ...Essays will be judged on originality and English usage Essays are to be double spaced and have a cover sheet with student's name, school and contact info (phone number). Winners are required to read their essays at the club meeting on April 11, at 7:15, at Connection Point Church, 1510 Campbell Road, Sidney, Ohio. Prizes will be awarded.
