### Shelby County Coin Club Scholarship 2024

#### Eligibility....

All Shelby County graduating seniors including homeschooling students and UVCC students who have been accepted to a two or four year college or trade school.

#### Requirements

Applicants must go to a local bank and purchase one roll each of old cents, old nickels, old dimes and old quarters. The coins may be returned when you finish. Get a verification from the teller that you purchased coins...usually a signed receipt will work. Look through each roll and consider the age, condition, and attributes of each denomination. Write a 500 word essay about your experience. For example, what was unusual about any of the coins if anything? . What was the oldest coin you found; newest coin; etc.? Remember...originality counts. Use your thinking skills.

Criteria ...Essays will be judged on originality and English usage Essays are to be double spaced and have a cover sheet with student's name, school and contact info (phone number). Winners are required to read their essays at the club meeting on April 11, at 7:15, at Connection Point Church, 1510 Campbell Road, Sidney, Ohio. Prizes will be awarded.

Essay deadline: **postmarked by March 29.**
