RUDOLF G. BERG SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

Purpose

Emerson has established a scholarship plan to assist in the cost of a college education for one student attending any Shelby County High School or the Upper Valley Career Center. The award is provided to the student in their senior year of high school.

Eligibility

The scholarship is open to all seniors who are presently attending any high school in Shelby County and to all seniors who are presently attending the Upper Valley Career Center, even if the high school is not located in Shelby County. Applicants must graduate from high school this year, be admitted by an accredited college or university, begin their studies this year, and pursue an associate or bachelor's degree at an accredited two or four-year college or university.

Selection

After applications have been submitted to Emerson Human Resources, one candidate will be chosen by a local Selection Committee appointed by Human Resources. This Selection Committee will consist of three local citizens who are highly regarded in the community. No one on the local Selection Committee may be an employee of the company.

Top qualifying applicants will be required to attend an in-person interview with the Selection Committee as part of the selection process.

The primary emphasis in the selection process will be good academic standing, need, and seriousness of purpose regarding academic and life goals. All factors will be given appropriate consideration as follows:

Administration

One student will be selected under this plan and will be eligible for an award of \$2,500. Each eligible student must have their Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or American College Test (ACT) scores and the Rudolf G. Berg application form submitted by March 31st of their senior year in high school. A student may select their own accredited college. (If, however, a student is accepted at and plans to attend a U.S. Service Academy, the scholarship will not be valid.)

Background

This one-year scholarship is named after Rudolf Berg who served as Vice President of sales for Copeland during the company's early years. He also played a significant role in shaping the curriculum of the Upper Valley Joint Vocational School.



Applications for the 2022 Rudolf G. Berg Scholarship are to be completed and returned to Emerson's Human Resources department by Thursday, March 31, 2022, along with an official updated transcript of your high school academic record and official results of tests taken, if available. (For example: ACT, SAT, College Entrance Board).
