## ATHLETIC PHYSICALS AND SPORTS CONTRACTS

Physical examinations are required of all student athletes each year <u>before</u> the first practice or try-out. Physicals are required of all students in Grades 7 through 12 — NO EXCEPTIONS. Athletic packets containing the physical evaluation forms and training contracts are available in all school offices and on your FinalForms account. <u>All paperwork must be uploaded to the FinalForms account.</u>

## ATHLETIC ELEGIBILITY

<u>High School</u>: Students athletes must be currently enrolled in school and have received a passing grade in a minimum of five one-credit courses, or the equivalent, in the immediately preceding grading period.

<u>Junior High</u>: In accordance with bylaws 4-4-4 and 4-4-5, students who are enrolled in a member 7th-8th grade school for the 2022/2023 school year will be required to pass a minimum of five courses of all subjects taken in the preceding grading period.

Athletic eligibility will require a minimum grade point average of 1.0 each grading period. Students who fail to meet this criteria as well as all other Ohio High School Athletic Association eligibility standards at the end of a grading period, will be ineligible for the following grading period.

## WORLD IN MOTION CAR DERBY

- A Student is defined as grades K 12, living in the same household. Once a student has graduated from high school they are considered an adult. All children not yet in kindergarten get in free of charge.

#### Adult All Sports Pass - \$150

An Adult All Sports Pass purchase includes one (1) Adult All Sports Pass. This pass will also include one (1) Reserve Football Seat.

- Passes are valid for one (1) admission to all HOME high school and all HOME junior high regularly scheduled athletic events.
- Passes are valid for the person's name (cardholder) that appears on the front of the pass. This pass will admit cardholder only.

#### Student All Sports Pass - \$60

A Student All Sports Pass purchase includes one (1) Student All Sports Pass.

- Pass can only be purchased by Fort Loramie Local Schools students (grades K 12)
- Pass is valid for one (1) admission to all HOME high school and all HOME junior high regularly scheduled athletic events.
- · Passes are valid for the person's name (cardholder) that appears on the front of the pass. This pass will admit cardholder only.

#### Multi - Event Pass - \$65 \*adults only

A Multi - Event Pass purchase includes one (1) 10-hole punch Multi - Event Pass.

- Passes are valid for one (1) admission to all HOME high school and all HOME junior high regularly scheduled athletic events.
- Passes are valid for the person's name (cardholder) that appears on the front of the pass. This pass will admit cardholder only.
- Passes cannot be used in exchange for Reserve Football Seats.

#### Reserve Football Seat - \$50

 $A\ Reserve\ Football\ Seat\ purchase\ will\ include\ one\ (1)\ Football\ Pass\ and\ rights\ to\ a\ reserve\ football\ seat.$ 

- Pass is valid for one (1) admission and reserve seat to all HOME varsity regularly scheduled football games.
- Pass is valid for the person's name (cardholder) that appears on the front of the pass. The pass will admit cardholder only.

#### FOR ALL PASSES:

- Passes will <u>not be honored</u> for away contests, conference tournaments, or post season OHSAA tournaments.
- Passes are NON-TRANSFERABLE and identification required upon request.
- Passes MUST be present to gain entrance to home varsity football games. Failure to present the pass may require a
  paid admission.
