BOARD BRIEFS

The following is a summary of the Regular Board of Education Meeting held on March 21, 2022.

- The Board approved minutes of the Regular Business Meeting held on February 21, 2022. The monthly financial report indicated February General Fund receipts of \$651,646 and expenditures of \$742,421. The anticipated carry-over balance for the end of the 2021-2022 fiscal year is \$6,963,384.
- In the Elementary Principal's report, Scott Rodeheffer reported as follows:
 - 1. AIR Testing:

April 5 & 6th - Grades 3-6 ELA

April 19 & 20 – Grades 3-6 Math

April 26 & 27 – 5th Grade Science

- -Everything will be done in the homeroom
- 2. Kindergarten Screening will be April 7th from 8:00am-4:00pm. We currently have 64 students registered for screening.
- In the Junior/Senior High School report, Mr. Hollenbacher reported as follows:

STATE TESTING

State Testing will begin at FLHS on April 6th, and this year, since all students that test have been provided a Chromebook, our testing will be done in the morning and we will utilize the 2-hour delay schedule to avoid interruptions with classes after testing is complete that day.

• Approved setting the student worker hourly rate to the minimum wage as outlined below:

Year 1: Minimum Wage

Year 2: Minimum Wage + .25

Year 3: Minimum Wage + .50

Note: Currently the minimum wage is \$9.30. This meets the IRS requirement for minimum wage for workers.

- Approved membership in the Sedgwick Compensation Group Rate Plan with an administrative fee of \$250.00.
- Approved the advancement of five (5) days of sick leave for Dan Jacobs.
- Approved the extended leave for Jessica Egbert.
- Approved two substitute classified cafeteria/custodial for the 2021/2022 school year at the previously approved hourly rates of pay.
