BOARD BRIEFS

The following is a summary of the Regular Board of Education Meeting held on April 18, 2022.

- The Board approved minutes of the Regular Business Meeting held on March 21, 2022. The monthly financial report indicated February General Fund receipts of \$1,380,238 and expenditures of \$799,238. The anticipated carry-over balance for the end of the 2021-2022 fiscal year is \$6,963,384.
- In the Elementary Principal's report, Scott Rodeheffer reported as follows:
 - 1. Kindergarten Screening went very well. Thanks goes out to Jenny Knouff, Joni Siegrist, and Jana Hoying for putting it all together. In addition, a big thank you to all of the volunteers who helped make it a successful day. We screened 66 potential kindergarteners for next year.
 - 2. Camp Willson Camp Willson this year will be a two-day (May 5 & 6) event but students will not be staying overnight. This is a nice cost savings for the students.
 - 3. Greenfield Village Fifth graders will be leaving for Greenfield Village on May 6th at 6:15am. Another great opportunity for our students to view, explore, and enjoy.
