- The Board approved minutes of the Regular Business Meeting held on March 25, 2024. The monthly financial report indicated March General Fund receipts of \$1,751,905 and expenditures of \$1,092,447. The anticipated carry-over balance for the end of the 2023-2024 fiscal year is \$7,350,305.
