BOARD BRIEFS

The following is a summary of the Regular Board of Education Meeting held on April 21, 2025.

- The Board approved minutes of the Regular Business Meeting held on March 12, 2025. The monthly financial report indicated March General Fund receipts of \$2,063,507 and expenditures of \$899,134. The anticipated carry-over balance for the 2024/2025 fiscal year is \$10,613,778.
- In the Elementary Principal's report, Scott Rodeheffer reported as follows:

BRIDGING BACK

Last week, eight of our junior students were able to participate in the Bridging Back Program put on by Workforce Partnership. While much of the Workforce Partnership's focus has been with students looking to enter the workforce after high school, this program is connecting college-bound students with local mentors to provide career guidance, development, and community connections to students. The first session took place at Edison State and by all accounts, it was a positive experience for our students who signed up for the program. We are hopeful this will continue with future classes at FLHS.
