BOARD BRIEFS

The following is a summary of the Regular Board of Education Meeting held on September 18, 2023.

- The Board approved minutes of the Regular Business Meeting held on August 21, 2023. The monthly financial report indicated August General Fund receipts of \$1,000,574 and expenditures of \$955,625. The anticipated carry-over balance for the end of the 2023-2024 fiscal year is \$9,192,186.
- In the Elementary Principal's report, Scott Rodeheffer reported as follows:

1. **Achievement**

This component represents whether student performance on state tests met established thresholds and how well students performed on tests overall.

Progress

This component looks closely at the growth all students are making based on their past performances.

Gap Closing

The Gap Closing Component is a measure of the reduction in educational gaps for student subgroups.

Early Literacy

The Early Literacy Component is a measure of reading improvement and proficiency for students in kindergarten through third grade.
