BOARD BRIEFS

The following is a summary of the Regular Board of Education Meeting held on October 21, 2024.

- The Board approved minutes of the Regular Business Meeting held on September 16, 2024. The monthly financial report indicated September General Fund receipts of \$719,807 and expenditures of \$682,608. The anticipated carry-over balance for the 2024/2025 fiscal year is \$10,613,778.
- In the Elementary Principal's report, Scott Rodeheffer reported as follows:
