BOARD BRIEFS

The following is a summary of the Regular Board of Education Meeting held on October 24, 2022.

- The Board approved minutes of the Regular Business Meeting held on September 12, 2022. The monthly financial report indicated September General Fund receipts of \$616,842 and expenditures of \$1,013,176. The anticipated carry-over balance for the end of the 2021-2022 fiscal year is \$7,009,469.
- In the Elementary Principal's report, Scott Rodeheffer reported as follows:

 2. The kindergarten – 2nd graders will be going to watch a science production "Air is Everywhere" in New Bremen on November 7th. Lock One Community Arts program is presenting the production. We would like to thank them for inviting us again this year.
