Mrs. Kristi Homan— Computers





She wrote, “I want to reach out to those with special needs because they are often overlooked. I want to reach out to those who are new in school because they don’t have any friends yet. And I want to reach out to those who are picked on or put down by others.”

Our goal is to show more kindness and compassion to each other and make a difference in each other’s lives. We have assemblies and fun activities planned, as well as daily lessons, about kindness and compassion. We look forward to Rising to the Challenge!
